!Residential Spring Clean!

The 2025 Spring residential clean-up is scheduled for May 5th, 6th, 7th, & 8th, (LAST DAY). Everyone is encouraged to gather the things you no longer use, need, or want that's cluttering up your home or outdoor space. This is a great time to make a *Clean Sweep* of your area since the city will haul off all of your unwanted stuff for **FREE!!**

What do *you* need to do to help make this *Clean Sweep* a success? **MONDAY morning, May 5th, get ALL the unwanted items out to the curb or road by 8 a.m.** Make sure the items can be seen by the workers. **DO NOT mix regular household garbage with the items that's being disposed of.** Limbs, yard waste, etc., are to be kept separate. **IF any yard waste is mixed with discarded items, Nothing will be picked up.**

Due to landfill regulations, the following things will not be picked up: **Hazardous waste of any kind, red bag medical waste, motor oil, no free flowing liquids, paint in liquid form, oil cans, auto batteries, freon filled components, dead animals, construction materials (remodels, window replacements, lumber, siding, etc.)**

TIRES: If you have old tires to dispose of, call 994-7338 for information on where to take them.

NOTE: *Once* the workers have finished clearing the discarded items on a street, they won't be back until fall. Don't miss this opportunity to spruce up your home and yard to get rid of any & all unwanted items.

E-waste must be taken to the Ash Flat Library parking lot located on Arnhart Street.

AMERICAN VETERANS MEMORIAL

The American Veterans Memorial in Ash Flat is located on Nix Ridge Road about a half mile from Wal-Mart. This 'living memorial' is for anyone that served in the U.S. Military. RECYCLABLES

Take glass containers to Independence County Recycling in Batesville, located at 110 Independence Drive. Always rinse out all/any glass or metal containers before recycling.

Ash Flat recycling center is open Tuesday 8-3. We accept metal & aluminum cans, #1 & #2 plastics, newspaper, magazines, & only **corrugated** boxes. Thank you for recycling!
